THE PURPLE LINE...AN EXTRAVAGANCE WE CAN'T AFFORD IN THESE DIFFICULT ECONOMIC TIMES

1. IT DOESN'T SOLVE THE MAIN PROBLEM OF TRAFFIC CONGESTION, AND MAY DELAY OTHER SOLUTIONS THAT WOULD. The Purple Line light rail system doesn't even address the major transportation problem in the Montgomery/ Prince George's area: traffic congestion.

- Studies show, and the State's project manager confirms, the Purple Line is **not intended to reduce traffic congestion**—80% of its riders will come from another form of mass transit, not from cars. Why would we build a new system that doesn't begin to address our biggest **transportation problem**?
- Because the Purple Line will be competing for funds, it is likely to push back the Corridor Cities Transit-way (CCT) that would provide much-needed relief for I-270 congestion. The CCT would serve an area with no public transit and that is expected to grow by some 725,000 in next decade. Thus, a project that actually could reduce traffic congestion will be delayed while we build a new system for those already using transit.

2. IT'S NOT COST-EFFECTIVE.

- Light rail is the most expensive mode per passenger carried.
- According to state figures, the Purple Line will actually serve approximately 6800 new riders.
 With a total price tag in the range of \$1.8 billion (in 2007 dollars!) that means the system will cost \$265,000.00 per new rider.

3. IT'S OBSOLETE BEFORE IT STARTS RUNNING.

- Plans for the Purple Line are already out of date they were developed before plans were set for BRAC.
- The planned relocation of the Walter Reed Army Medical Center to the National Naval Medical Center in Bethesda in 2011 is projected to generate an estimated **900,000 new car trips per year**, **but this area will not be served by the Purple Line**.

4. IT'S NOT AS ENVIRONMENTALLY-FRIENDLY AS HAS BEEN REPRESENTED.

- As the Purple Line is not projected to dramatically reduce the number of cars on the road, it will **not significantly reduce vehicle pollution** or improve air quality as originally believed.
- The Purple Line will be built over what is now largely residential and recreational green space, reducing public access to some of the last open space in Montgomery and Prince George's Counties and requiring the **destruction of a minimum of 1000 mature trees**.

- The rail line will have a **major impact on the Capital Crescent Trail**, used by an estimated 10,000 individuals per week. In places the trail is only 33 feet wide and there is no way that walkers, hikers, joggers and cyclists can safely coexist unless the path is widened, requiring the taking of additional land from adjacent green space and existing properties.
- Though the state suggests that the Purple Line and trail users can happily co-exist, the construction phase of the line will actually destroy much of the trail as it is currently configured. And, contrary to popular belief, funds/plans to re-build are not in the Purple Line project budget but would be the responsibility of Montgomery County

5. THE PURPLE LINE WILL SEVERELY IMPACT NEIGHBORHOODS ALONG ITS ROUTE

- Serious safety concerns are raised by high-speed trains traveling on residential streets alongside homes and yards, adjacent to schoolyards and pedestrian areas.
- According to the DEIS, neighborhoods along the route will be severely impacted:
 - 64 intersections along the route will need improvements, such as new turn lanes, to prevent traffic from worsening where vehicles will share travel lanes with light rail trains or express buses.
 - As many as four Montgomery County Schools will lose tracts of land to the line.
 - Sound walls and panels covering train wheels would be necessary to protect residents in up to 18 "potential annoyance zones" from the screech of metal train wheels turning sharp corners. Without such protections, noise levels could be severe for residents.

6. IT'S FAR FROM CLEAR THAT THE PURPLE LINE IS THE SMARTEST WAY TO SPEND LIMITED TRANSIT DOLLARS

- The Town of Chevy Chase commissioned an independent study which found alternatives (including Jones Bridge) are cheaper, faster, and more effective in getting people out of cars.
- By looking at best practices in other communities, it seems clear there are alternatives that can effectively move more people at a lower cost per rider and with less impact on green space and existing residential neighborhoods.

7. HOW WILL WE PAY FOR IT?

- Less expensive and more efficient alternatives such as the Jones Bridge are more likely to achieve federal funding.
- In the October 18, 2008 *Washington Post*, State officials admitted they will have trouble paying for the Purple Line.
- According to the state, its measure for cost-effectiveness -- a key consideration for securing critical federal money -- barely meets federal eligibility standards. (Washington Post, October 18)

As for the "not in my backyard" syndrome, it's understandable, and for some lamentable. I'm sorry, I've been "built up on" too, and I understand those concerns.

But we must serve the public objective to do the greatest good for the greatest number.

The NIMBYism of the Chevy Chase golf club, however, I can not support. The public Right of Way exists to serve the public good, not for your golf game and country club pursuits. With the Purple Line, you will continue to enjoy those things, and you can afford to sacrifice just a little for everyone else. (With a slightly smaller golf course, you may find your golf scores actually improve.)

I fully support the Purple Line design that would retain and widen the existing Capital Crescent bike trail, and interconnect with an improved network of bike routes.

I also fully support a Purple Line design that enhances pedestrian safety and encourages walking as a growing form of public transit.

As for Silver Spring, most folks support mass transit and the Purple Line. But there will be some adverse impacts to our neighborhoods if the Medium Investment light rail option is selected with a route through downtown and Wayne Avenue.

If that option is selected, I urge you to adopt the best pedestrian and bicycle safety measures and improvements into the Purple Line design.

And I urge you to go further to incorporate these additional mitigation features into the design:

1. Rehabilitation of the recreational track at Sligo Creek Elementary school with an all weather, padded surface.

2. Rehabilitation of the athletic field at Sligo Creek Elementary school by installing durable, artificial turf.

3. Systematically improve bike lanes and surfaces in the area.

We need to look beyond mass transit and encourage walking, running, and biking as part of the Purple Line solution. And I believe we can come up with cost sharing strategies to accomplish them:

• By fixing the track, we will provide citizens with a vital, accessible, and safe resource for their walking and running exercise.

• By fixing the athletic field, we will encourage soccer as a "carry over" sport for all ages by providing a safe, accessible, and durable resource.

 \cdot By improving the bike lanes and surfaces, we will increase bike commuting use.

All these mitigation features will enhance the community and yield long term benefits by bolstering alternative transit strategies to the culture of the automobile. And people from the community can be joined there by people using the Purple Line.

To conclude, the Purple Line will connect diverse communities throughout its length, provide cultural and economic opportunities for the people, and bring us together in a way that helps both the region and the planet.


