# Overview of Roadway Improvements

- Connection from Quesada Road to the signalized intersection of Kenilworth Avenue at Rittenhouse Street
- Continuous sidewalks and bike lanes along both sides of Kenilworth Avenue from River Road to East-West Highway
- New Traffic Signal at East-West Highway and Riverdale Road/58<sup>th</sup> Avenue (SHA Project)
- Relocation of Mustang Drive to intersect Riverdale Road directly opposite 62<sup>nd</sup> Place and 63<sup>rd</sup> Avenue closed as a cul-de-sac



# Overview of Roadway Improvements

- New sidewalk along the south side of Riverdale Road from Riverdale Road/58<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Mustang Drive (SHA Project)
- Eastpine Drive closed as cul-de-sac and extension of 64<sup>th</sup> Avenue across Riverdale Road to Patterson Street
- Left and right turn lanes on Riverdale Road at 67<sup>th</sup> Avenue (the existing westbound left turn time restriction will be lifted)
- 67<sup>th</sup> Place will be closed as a cul-de-sac at Riverdale Road

## WORK EXECUTED IN 2017: RIVERDALE PARK AREA

- Sediment and erosion control measures were installed along Kenilworth Road and Riverdale Road
- PEPCO conducted tree trimming
- HAZMAT assessments and abatement were conducted
- Shell station was fenced and building was demolished
- Surveying was conducted to establish limit of disturbance (LOD) and right of way (ROW) areas along the route
- Investigations on utilities were completed
- Investigations on geotechnical were completed
- Environmental reviews were completed
- Design and engineering is in progress



## CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES JANUARY – JUNE 2018

- Kenilworth Road
  - Initial grading and drainage work will occur
  - Utilities will start to be relocated
  - The tax office on Kenilworth will be demolished
  - Site work such as demolition, grading, drainage, curbs, gutters, will start
- Riverdale Road
  - Initial grading and drainage work will occur
  - Clearing and grubbing will occur on both sides of the road
  - Utilities relocation
  - The underground fuel tanks at the old Shell station location removed
  - The Exxon station will be demolished and underground fuel tanks removed
  - MOT to establish work areas
  - Perform drilled shafts for the Kenilworth Ave crossover bridge
  - MOT set up at BW Parkway

## CONSTRUCTION WORK HOURS

- **Day shift work hours** are 7:00 AM – 5 PM Monday – Friday
- **Night shift work hours** are 8:00 PM – 4:30 AM Monday – Friday when required
- **Lane closures will be** 9:00 AM – 3:00 PM Monday—Friday or per specification requirements
- **Weekend** work may occur as needed to support construction operations

## MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC—WHAT TO EXPECT

- Existing traffic patterns will change as work occurs
- Work may occur on both sides of the road and across roadways
- When a lane closure is required, a notice will be distributed
- Orange cones and barrels (temporary barricades) will be in place
- Flag-person, when required, will direct traffic
- Underground utility work may require temporary road plates
- **Operations may be done at off-peak hours**
