## Application for Temporary Noise Waiver

October 27, 2022

The Department of Environmental Protection is currently reviewing an application for a Temporary Noise Waiver as allowed under the Montgomery County Noise Control Ordinance, Chapter 31B, Section 11(a). The Department will receive comments on the application for a minimum of ten (10) days after distribution of this notice.

The Temporary Noise Waiver is being requested by Purple Line Maryland Transit Partners, 6811 Kenilworth Ave., Suite 400, Riverdale, Maryland, for the purpose of constructing a structural retaining wall as part of a parking lot renovation at 8600 16<sup>th</sup> St., Silver Spring. This work is part of the Purple Line Project and nighttime construction is being requested to expedite restoration of resident parking at the 8600 Apartments. The after-hours activities will involve excavation and backfilling equipment and retaining wall construction. The work is scheduled to continue through the end of December 2022. Designated work hours are 7:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. Sunday through Saturday nights.
